Sorry I didn't get this to you yesterday.

Judi and I have had a look. We haven't changed anything but have added a few comments.

Our main concern is committing public funds to support these young people/parents, when a number have refused to engage with CYMHS interventions in the past. We are worried this may set a precedence, though understand the need to manage the situation sensitively.

Our other concern is where this funding will be accessed, as we have not budgeting this into our Adolescent Mental Health Extended Treatment Initiative (AMHETI) Business Case. [REDACTED]

The point is that further promises of support to the other Barrett families could conceivably see funding requirements increase to well over \$150000/year, with no end date specified. None of this is budgeted.
