Dear Leanne,

I endorse the proposed documents. The only issues I may have in the "Proposed Service Model" are with the wording "[Consumers will only access the day sessions \(i.e. Day Program components\) of the service if they are an admitted consumer](#)".

We discussed that if the Tier 3 service was on an area which did not have a day program it could include day patients. This statement could be interpreted that way - they can be a day patient as long as they are admitted to the service. It is also possible that it could be co-located with a Tier 2 service to maximise resources. There is enough flexibility in the statement, or in the subsequent process of developing a model of service delivery for these not to be an issue.

The only other comment is that while the pre-able identifies the lack of a step-down unit as contributing to length of stay, the Tier 3 service makes no reference to a step-down unit, apart from being one of the key principles. Again, this is not an issue which could not be added in at a later stage perhaps, because it is identified in the principles.

Leanne, you have done a brilliant job of articulating the discussions we have had. I looked at the time you sent this through, and just want to thank you for all the hard work you have put in which intruded into your own family time.
